Dear Labor Day Parade Participant:

Thank you for being a part of the *Monday, September 5, 2016* Labor Day Parade festivities.

Enclosed you will find a map with your union's line-up location.

****The parade line-up will begin at 7:00 a.m. and the parade itself will begin at 9:00 a.m.****

REMINDER: *There will be no throwing candy or other items from floats or vehicles. If you have items to hand out to on-lookers, you must have "walkers" to walk alongside your float or vehicle to hand out your candy or favor. PLEASE ADHERE TO THIS RULE TO PROTECT ONLOOKERS!*

Please enter your floats and vehicles for the parade lineup from Jefferson Street. NOTE: **No parade staging is allowed on 19th and 20th Streets between Olive and Locust and no staging is allowed in the westbound lane of Olive between 19th and 20th Streets.** These streets must remain clear for use by the St. Louis Police Department.

We ask that you try to keep trash to a minimum so that the city of St. Louis will continue to allow us to host the Labor Day Parade. Trash bags will be provided and there will be a large dumpster located at Poelker Park at Tucker and Market.

It is extremely important for you to pass this crucial information on to anyone participating in the parade. These rules must be followed for the safety and enjoyment of all attending and involved in the parade.

All of this information will be discussed at the Marshal's meeting scheduled for 5:30 p.m. (prior to the delegate meeting) on Tuesday, August 16, 2016 at the IBEW, Local #1 Hall.
