This year's Labor Day Parade will be held on Monday, September 6, 2021 in Downtown St. Louis, with the line-up beginning at 7:00 a.m. **The parade start-time is 9:00 a.m.**

We are encouraging union participation and would like a show of real solidarity from our St. Louis area unions!

- Please complete the enclosed entry form and mail it to the Labor Council office along with your entry fee of \$275 as soon as possible. Please make the check payable to **"St. Louis Labor Council Parade."**
- Unions wishing to march in the parade with sister locals must clearly indicate this on the parade application.
- Unions celebrating a *significant* anniversary (i.e. 25 or 50 years) should call the Labor Council office in advance to receive special (front-line) placement.

We must receive this information no later than Friday, July 16, 2021 for your union to be included in the line-up placement which will be determined by lottery at the Tuesday, July 20, 2021 St. Louis Labor Council Delegate Council Meeting, held at the IBEW, Local 1 Hall, 5850 Elizabeth Ave. in St. Louis at 6:30 p.m. You MUST have your information in before this meeting to be included in the drawing!

PLEASE NOTE:

No candy or handouts of any kind may be thrown from floats. You must inform your truck or float operators that they must have walkers to walk along side the float or truck if you wish to hand out anything to the parade observers. This will guard against children running into the street and prevent possible injuries.
